



RESOLUTION NO. 6-10

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AN ALL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF SOUTH BETHANY, DELAWARE

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, as amended, requires that local government develop and adopt natural hazard mitigation plans in order to receive certain federal assistance; and


WHEREAS, a local Hazard Mitigation Advisory Committee comprised of county governmental departments, municipal Council members, the business community, non-profit organization, and citizens working in Sussex County of the State of Delaware, convened in order to study the Town of South Bethany's risks from, and vulnerabilities to natural, technological and terrorism and to make recommendations on mitigating the effects of such hazards on the Town; and

WHEREAS, a contract was issued to an experienced consulting firm to work with the Sussex County Hazard Mitigation Advisory Committee and the Delaware Emergency Management Agency to develop a comprehensive all hazard mitigation plan for Sussex County of Delaware; and

WHEREAS, the efforts of the Town of South Bethany, Sussex County, and the consulting firm have resulted in the development of an All Hazard Mitigation Plan for the county and the Town of South Bethany;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of South Bethany that the All Hazard Mitigation Plan dated September 2004 and updated March 2010 is hereby approved and adopted for the Town of South Bethany and Sussex County of the State of Delaware. A copy of the plan is attached to this resolution.


